This month's ministry focus will be "The Word In Creation." While most of my messages will be dealing with God's Creations of the universe, there is much to be said about the new creations we have become. Paul goes on to say in 2 Corinthians 5:17, "behold, all things have become new."

A transformed life, from the old way to a new way, is evidence of the saving grace of our LORD. This is not sinless, perfection, but there must be clear evidence of a changed life. This new creation starts with the renewing of our minds (Romans 12:1-2). In other words, our thought process is different, even if our deeds are not.

A new creation means not thinking the same about sin as we did in the past. When we fall short, the Holy Ghost prompts us to confess our faults. We no longer glory in our sin, but feel a sorrow in our heart for the disappointment the Spirit of God feels.

Our new creation also stirs a hunger for the Word of God. Personal devotion becomes automatic and a desire to develop our faith is second nature. This is what a new creature in Christ Jesus looks like.
